Charles B. Rangel Graduate Fellowship

Eligibility

Applicants must

- be U.S. citizens
- be seeking admission to enter graduate school in the fall of 2019 for a two-year program in an area of relevance to the Foreign Service at a U.S.-based university
- have a cumulative grade point average of 3.2 or higher on a 4.0 scale at the time of application

Program Elements

- Support for graduate studies of up to \$37,500 per year for two years
- Two summer internships (Capitol Hill and overseas at U.S. Embassies/Consulates)
- Mentoring from a Foreign Service Officer
- Employment in the State Department Foreign Service for those who successfully complete the program and meet Foreign Service entry requirements, in accordance with applicable law and State Department policy

Application Deadline: September 17, 2018

The Charles B. Rangel International Affairs Graduate Fellowship Program is a U.S. Department of State program administered by Howard University for individuals interested in becoming Foreign Service Officers.
